Hello Everyone,

Just writing to clarify where we are with current public health restrictions in Nova Scotia. The province has now moved to Phase 2 of the opening plan.

The section that applies to us is listed under the “Meetings” heading:

“Meetings and training (indoor and outdoor) - 25% of the venue's capacity up to 50 people indoors and up to 75 people outdoors when meetings and training are hosted by a business or organization, including:

- *provincial and municipal government*
- *private businesses and organizations*
- *first responder organizations (emergency first responders are exempt from social distancing when necessary)*
- *mental health and addictions support groups*
- *organized clubs “*

This would mean, for example, that a space that has a fire code limit of 150 people would be allowed **up to 37** people with physical distancing. Keep in mind we still have to wear masks and follow all other public health guidelines.

Nice to see things starting to reopen and that we can start meeting in person once again.
