

Hello everyone and Happy New Year!

I just saw the update from Nova Scotia Public Health (<https://novascotia.ca/news/release/?id=20210108004>) and unfortunately although they have decided to relax some restrictions, the limit on gatherings both private and in public has not changed. This restriction remains at 10 until at least Jan 24th. There is some additional information to this though. Kyle P, a member in Cape Breton, asked about a how that restriction might apply in a certain instance. He asked if 2 groups of 10 can meet in the same big building (in this case an old school) if they use separate entrances, hallway is blocked between them and they do not mingle outside, all other public health precautions to be taken as well. He did receive a response from public health and the answer was that yes this is an option. I want to thank Kyle for taking the initiative to ask Public Health this and for forwarding the answer. This might be an option for groups that meet in a large enough building.

Thank you everyone for everything you're doing working to keep carrying the message, this is definitely not an easy time.
